A regular council meeting of the Lake City Council was brought to order at 5:30 pm by the Honorable Mayor Cameron Tate.

The meeting was opened with a prayer and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The roll having been called and the following councilmembers answered to their names: BRENDA HUTCHESON, KATE WELLS, TOMMY EAKINS, HARMONY CASH, JAKE EMERY, DANNY DUNIGAN. The meeting continued with the above members and the city Clerk Lisa Sitz present. (6/0).

GUESTS: Lana Tate, Linda Simpson, Misty Cole, Chad & Valarie Moody, Bryan Wells, Daniel Haynes, Jon Milligan, Chris Walker.

A motion by Councilmember Hutcheson and seconded by Councilmember Dunigan to approve the minutes from the regular council meeting held May 17, 2021. Motion passed. (6/0)

Mayor Cameron Tate discussed the financial statements.

Daniel Haynes addressed the council about the legal way of accepting donations for the Lake City Little League. A motion made by Councilmember Hutcheson and seconded by Councilmember Wells to accept all Little League donations from all parties in the amount of \$12,121.36 into the Parks Fund. Motion passed (5/0) with 1 Councilmember abstaining.

Mayor Tate discussed with the council the need for the city to have an ordinance for the disposal of furniture. A motion by Councilmember Dunigan and seconded by Councilmember Cash to have the City Attorney draw up an ordinance for furniture pick-up for disposal and set fees for drop-off furniture (up to 5 pieces) at \$5.00 and for pick-up of furniture (up to 5 pieces) at \$15.00. Motion passed (6/0).

Mayor Tate asked the council to renew the Vehicle Lease Agreement for the Mayor and the City Clerk for 2021. A motion by Councilmember Hutcheson and seconded by Councilmember Cash to renew the vehicle lease agreement for Mayor Tate and City Clerk Lisa Sitz for 2021. The City agrees to lease their personal vehicles for the sum of one (1) dollar. Motion passed (6/0).

The City received 3 sealed bids for the 2011 & 2012 Dodge Chargers. A motion by Councilmember Cash and seconded by Councilmember Wells to accept the highest bid from Emergency Remarketing for the 2011 Dodge Charger in the amount of \$1389.14 and the 2012 Dodge Charger in the amount of \$1689.14. Motion passed (6/0).

Mayor Tate asked the Council to approve the 2019 Legislative Audit as each member has received notice
that the City's audit had no findings. A motion by Councilmember Dunigan and seconded by
Councilmember Cash to accept the 2019 Legislative Audit. Motion passed (6/0).
